- 4. Must deliver the story within three (3) to five (5) minutes only.
- 5. Use of props and/or costumes are allowed.

- 1. Must be based on the theme
- 2. Must use 1/4 illustration board
- 3. Can use any coloring materials
- 4. Each contestant will be given a maximum one (1) hour and thirty (30) minutes only.

## 3. CRITERIA FOR JUDGING

# A. Story Telling

Does the storyteller pronounce the words correctly and clearly?	10%
Does the storyteller speak loudly enough	10%
to be heard by the audience?  Is the voice inflection used to	20//
enhance/interpret the story?	10%
Does the storyteller maintain good eye contact by looking at the audience?	10%
Does the storyteller tell the story at a comfortable pace?	10%
Is the storyteller composed? Does he/she avoid using distracting mannerism?	10%
Are body language, facial expressions, gestures effective and appropriate to the	10%
story?  Does the storyteller hold the attention of	
the audience throughout the story?	10%
Overall presentation/captivating quality	10%
